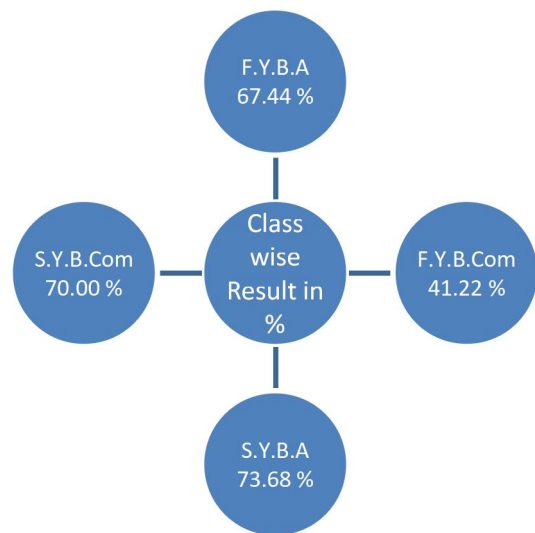
In a short period of six years our college has become very famous for many academic activities; our student strength therefore has increased significantly shown in the following table.

Library Section of MatoshreeSumatiChintamaniTipnis College of Arts & Commerce was established on 13.06.2008. The Library ordered 483 books till academic year 2013-14, which included 370 academic text books, 87 miscellaneous books, 11 reference books, and 10 competitive examination books. In current academic year 2014-15, 277 new books were increased. It includes 147 textbooks, 117 miscellaneous books, 6 competitive examination books, 12 reference books etc.

Hon. S. S. Phadkar (Hon. Chairman, VidyaMandirMandal) had donated 12 reference books of Income Tax Law subject. His valuable gift is worth beneficial for students, teachers and others.

In the academic year 2014-15 as per demand of the teachers academic subject related journals as in discussion.

In the current academic year 2014-15 as per the demand of 230 more books and subject related journals by professors, the library is in discussion for purchasing those. In the library there are 760 books till date. Daily newspapers like Times of India, Lokmat, Loksatta, Maharashtra Times, Krushival Samna, Sakal Weekly Magazines like Ambar, Vartusutra, Career related Magazines like Lokrajya, COMDEX Times are available in the library.

In the library daily 30 to 40 students and 10 to 12 teachers and non-teaching staff are coming to read. In the library daily exchange of books are recorded in 'Book Exchange Register Book'. Books are given as a home issue. The books are distributed class wise for students and for teacher the books are registered in a separate 'Book Exchange Register Book' for keeping library records there is a computer which is useful for daily work. Internet facility is also available.

For completing all work in the library within time e- *Granthalay- 3.0* software is available. The training to use it is also given by the IT person. At present making entries of books is in progress. By this software a librarian can get information of demanded books.

Library gets all help from the institution time to time.
