Total number of books in 2015-16 were 1455 in the library. Today the number of books in 2015-16 were 1455 in the library. Today the number of books are 1929. It is increased by 474 books. This 474 books comprises of 392 books of commerce, 63 books of arts and 7 reference books.

Mr. Diwakar Gandhe and Mr. Potdar Sir, the treasurer of the institution gifted four anthology of poetry on the occasion of 'Marathi Literature day. Similarly Miss yogita dalavi the student of T.Y.B.Com. gifted four books of S.Y.B.Com. to the library as well. Each and every day, the library of the college avails the various newspapers both in English and Marathi languages including the Times of India, The Economics Times, Lokmat, Loksatta, Maharashtra Times, Sakal, Krishival and samana etc.

The racks of the library are transformed into cupboards in 2016-17. The regular timing of the library is from 9 o' clock in the morning till 4 o' clock in the evening. Everyday, approximately 40 to 50 students visit library and read books and newspapers as well. Similarly all the teaching staff as well as non-teaching staff of the college visit the library.

The library has the perfect ventilation and good facilities of electricity . It is well equipped with sufficient no. of tables and chairs . it has total 14 cupboards, 15 chairs and 4 tables.



There is also a computer in the library to make the records of everyday working. The Software named “e-Granthalaya-3.0” is being used to register all the books. The formal training is already received regarding the software. Currently, all the records of the books are being registered in the software.

Whenever any new book is arrived in the library, firstly it is entered in ‘Accession register’. Issuing of books taken place everyday through formal entries in ‘Register Book’. The discussion about periodicals is being happened everyday in the library. Likewise, there is an intention to bring many more new books in to the library for forthcoming academic years.

Being a crescent institution, to make it knowledgeable, the library is being fully helped by our institution Vidya Mandir Mandal, Mahim.
