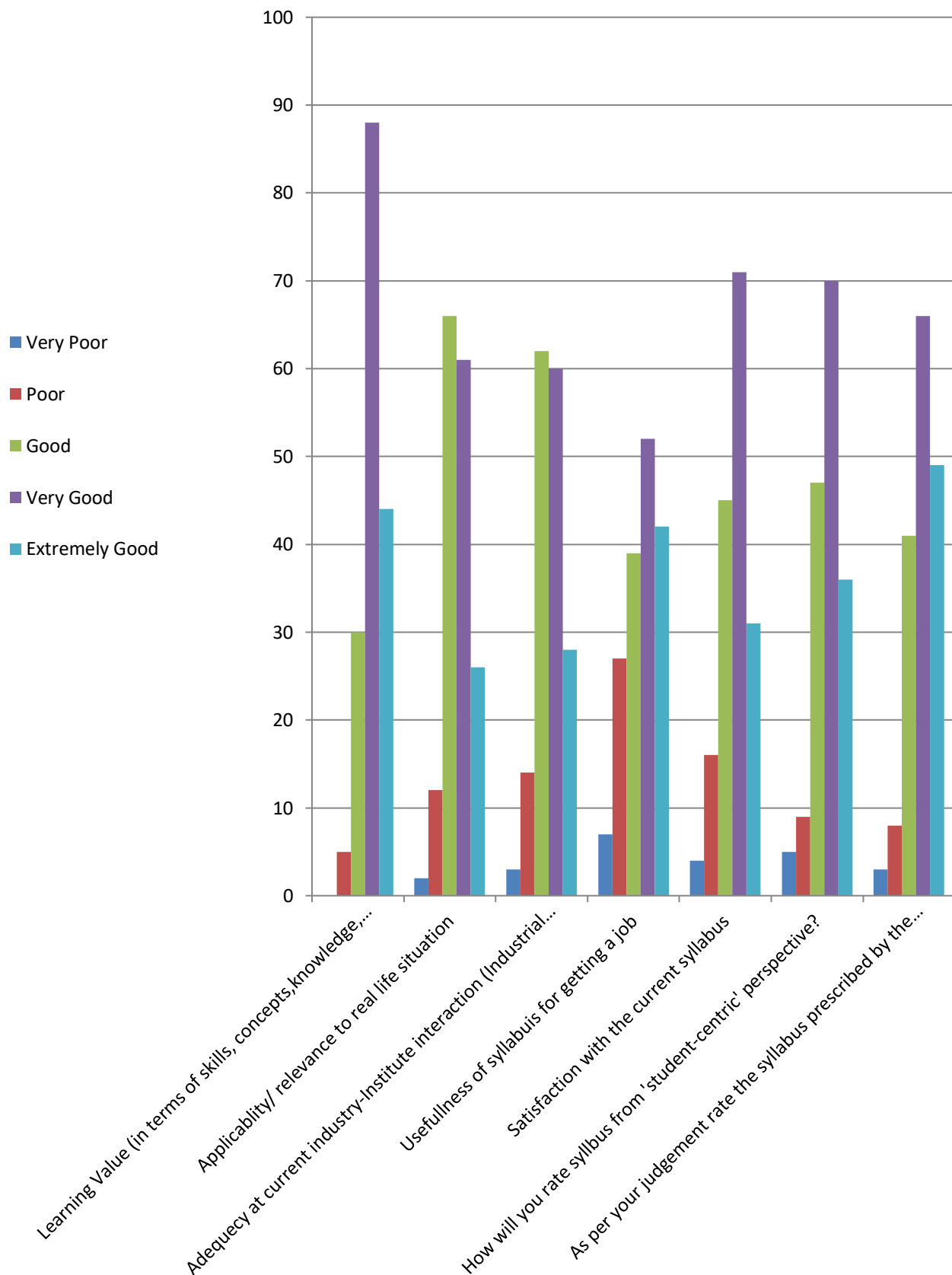

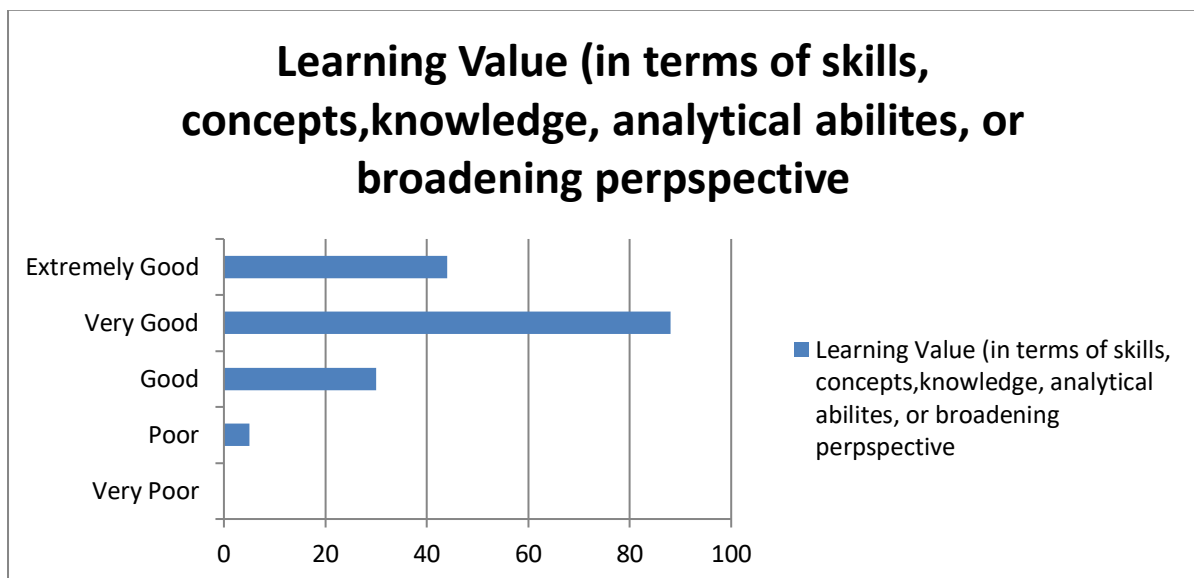
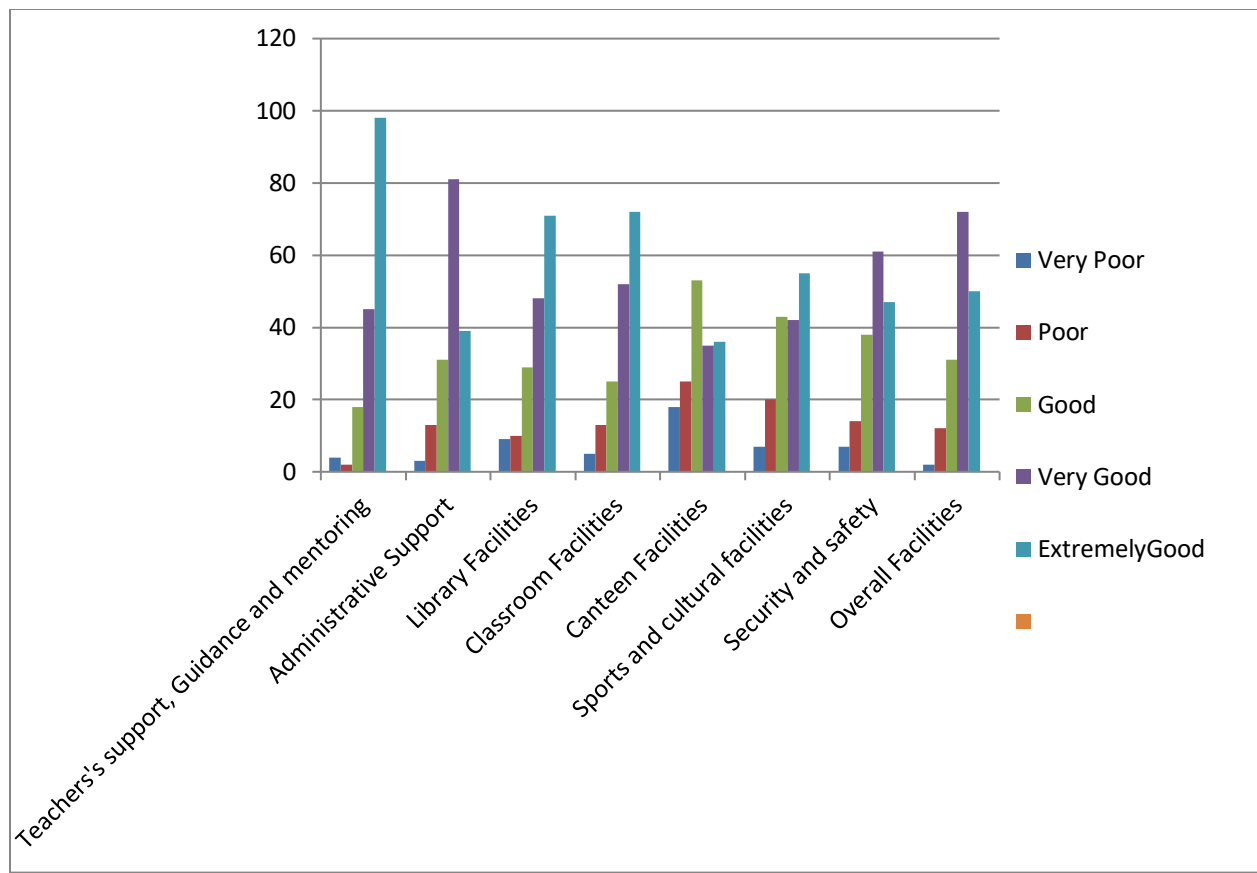
- 167 students' feedbacks were collected and analyzed.

- 90% of students are satisfied with teachers in terms of guidance and mentoring.

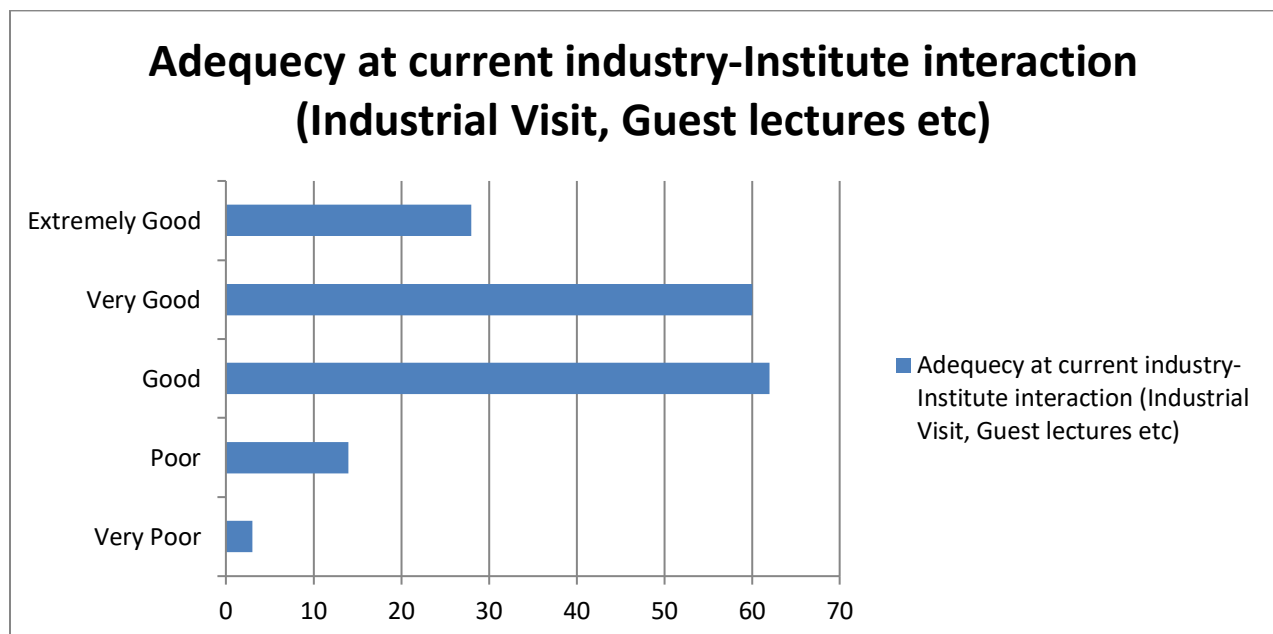
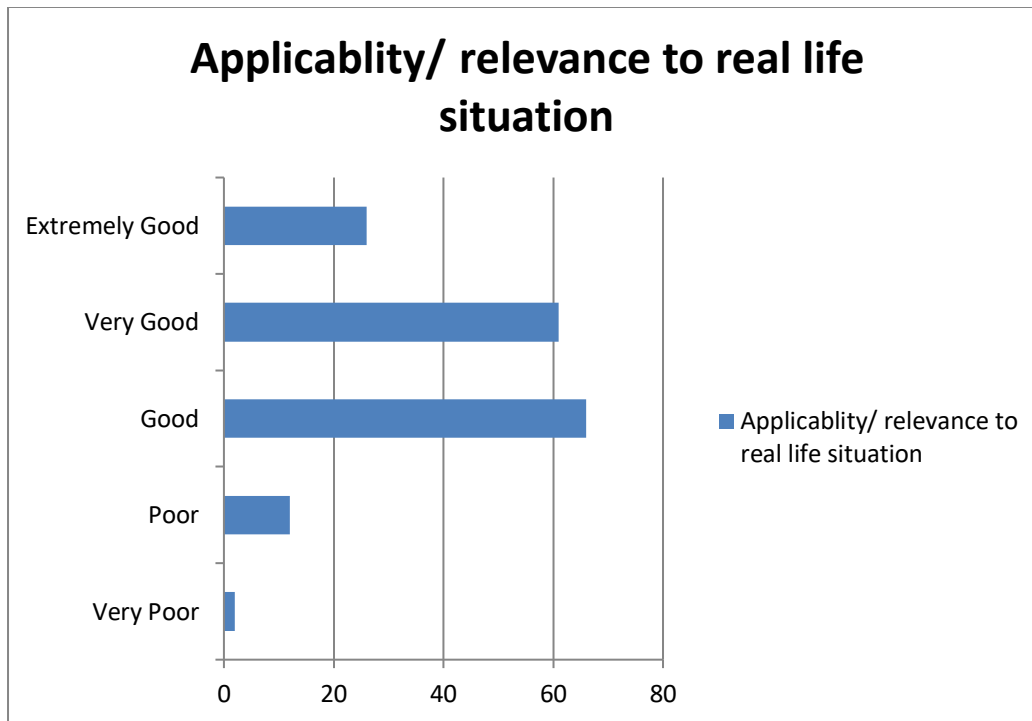

- Almost 90% of the students look satisfied as none of them rated the syllabus 'poor' or 'very poor'.

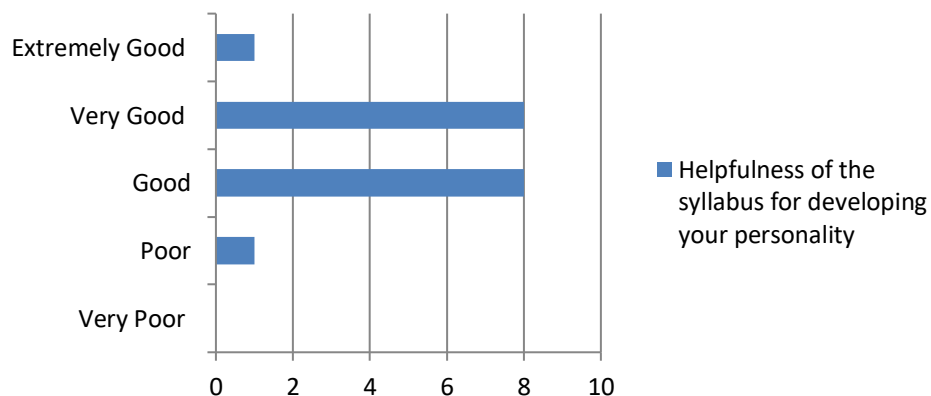

- Almost 85 % of students are satisfied with library, Canteen and sports facilities. However there are some suggestions for the improvement of canteen facilities.

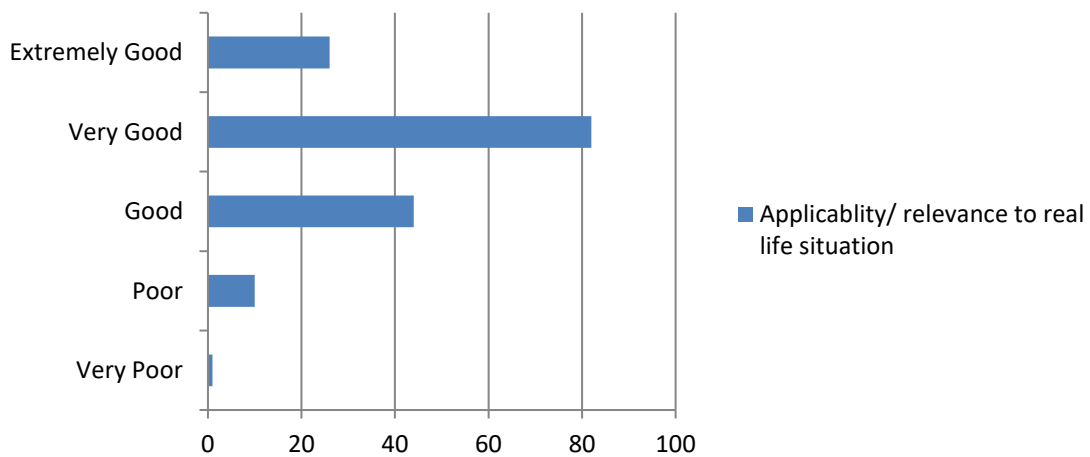

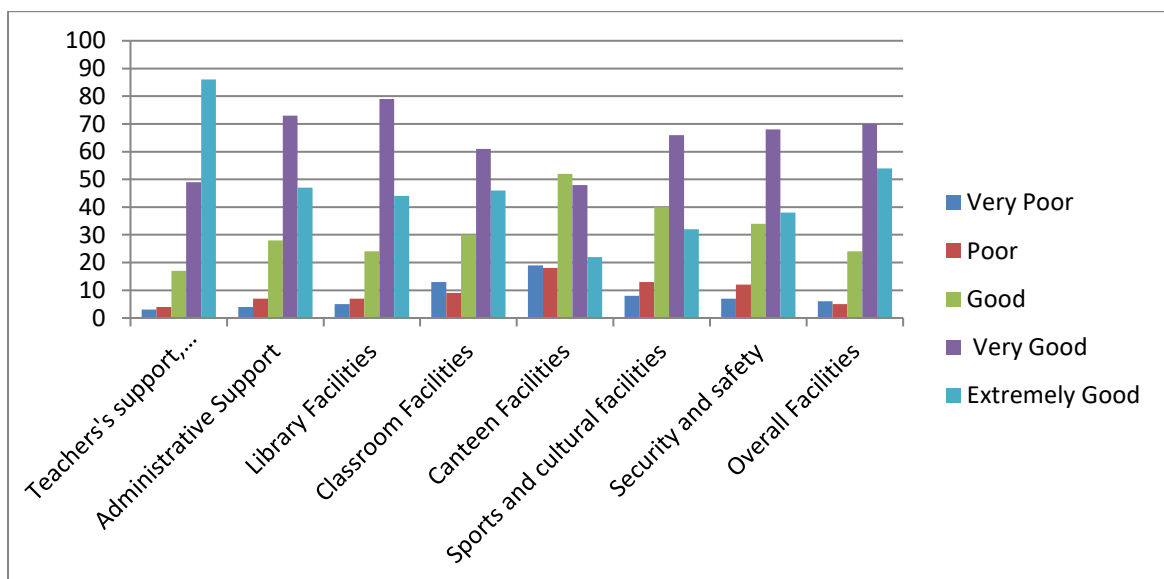
Synopsis: In the academic year 2018-19 we collected Students feedback of all the classes of commerce and Arts. Students were asked to give their valuable feedback on Syllabus prescribed by the University of Mumbai as well as on administration and resources. Following was the response of the students for the questionnaire asked:

- 159 students' feedbacks were collected and analyzed.
- 90% of the students rated the syllabus "Very Good" when it comes learning value. However, 8 students rated the syllabus 'Poor' for learning value.
- Only 12 students among 159 rated the syllabus 'Poor' for its applicability to real situations. Although 90 students rated the syllabus 'Very Good' for the same.
- 76 students find the syllabus very helpful for getting a job while some students disagree with the majority of the students. 11 students rated the syllabus 'very poor' in order to get a job.

- Almost 90 % of students are satisfied with library, Canteen and sports facilities.

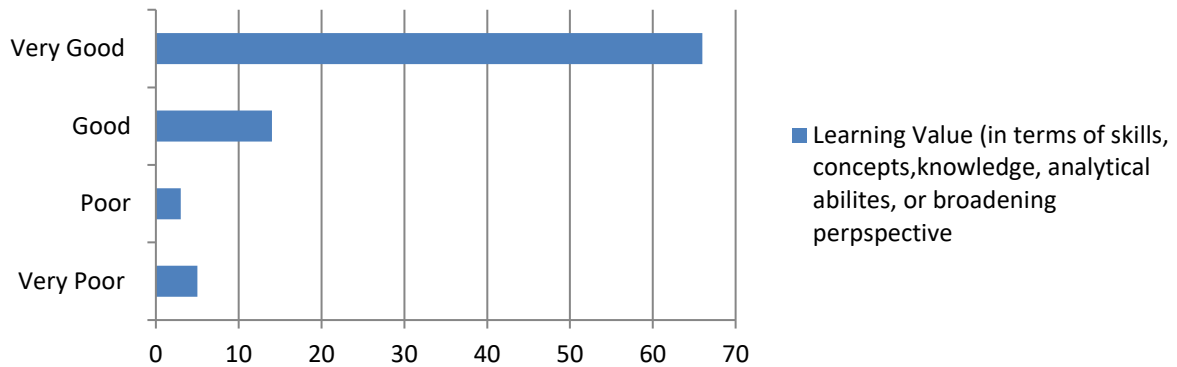
