


- ➤ 167 students' feedbacks were collected and analyzed.

- ➤ 90% of students are satisfied with teachers in terms of guidance and mentoring.




- ➤ Almost 50% of students rated the syllabus 'Good' when it comes to cocurricular activities.

- Almost 90% of the students look satisfied as none of them rated the syllabus 'poor' or 'very poor'.





















Alumni Feedback Analysis 2018-19




- Almost 50% of students rated the syllabus 'Good' when it comes to cocurricular activities.

- Almost 90% of the students look satisfied as none of them rated the syllabus 'poor' or 'very poor'.






















Action Taken Report
