

### <u>Annual Report – Academic Year 2018–19</u>

The Principal and the Staff of the College are contented to present the annual report for the Academic Year 2018-19. The College commenced its activity with the commitment to Quality Education and the overall development of the students. It grooms students not only to acquire knowledge and recognition, but also become responsible citizens of India. We assess the students' strength and weakness in academics and aptitude and address their needs through various Certificate Courses, Modules on Personality Development, Courses on Life Skills, Courses on Global Competencies and Counseling Courses. We use (ICT) Information& Communication Technology and other visual aids in our teaching methods. Remedial and Tutorial Classes, Project Work, and continuous Internal Assessment, Seminars, Guest Lectures etc. are also organized. ### **Details of activities in various Departments**

### **Commerce and Accountancy Department:**

• Commerce and Accountancy department organized a workshop on **Financial Literacy and Consumer Awareness** on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2018 at 8 a.m. Two sessions were conducted in the program. Resource persons for the workshop were **Mr. Nandkumar Menon** and **Mr. Mishra** from **Consumer Guidance Society of India**. After welcome ceremony Mr. Menon sir started 1st session of workshop on the topic of **Financial Literacy** with discussion over topics of management of money, how to become smart investor, utilization of savings and creating emergency funds etc. Second session of the workshop was conducted on consumer awareness. Mr. Mishra sir informed that consumer can complain on mah.helpline@gmail.com

- regarding any issue related with product. He also provided Maharashtra Consumer Helpline Toll Free number 1800-222262. Students' enrollment for both sessions was 180.
- On 10<sup>th</sup> August 2018, Department organized guidance lecture on **Banking Sectors Services in the 21<sup>st</sup> century**. Programme was scheduled at 9.30a.m. Resource Person for the lecture was Mrs. Gavari madam (Manager of State Bank of India, Neral Branch) and Mr. Thorat Sir. After felicitation of all the honorable dignitaries, Mrs. Gavari madam lectured on services provided by Banks. She introduced **SBI New App Yono** which is being used for opening SBI(State Bank of India) account through internet banking. She also informed students about usage of BHIM app. Mr. Thorat sir explained how SBI bank is better than other national banks. He next informed that there is a educational loan facilities available in SBI bank for students. He also told about various facilities which are provided by government for young entrepreneurs' growth and how one can avail these benefits from it. During the lecture, proper interaction was held between students and resource persons. Next, the programmeconcluded with vote of thanks.
- Department of Economics and Commerce organized an **Industrial Visit**on 11<sup>th</sup> Aug 2018 at Poshir near Neral railway station at Udasin Shriram Plastic ltd. It was informed that the company produces 1100-1200 high quality and low quality chairs per day. Company uses wastage material for production of low quality chairs. Company products were mainly sold in Hyderabad, Raipur, Ahmadabad, and Mumbai. Total 48 students from T.Y.B.A and T.Y.B.Com were presented and benefited from industrial visit. Prof. Sagar Mohite and Prof. Minakshi Chaudhari motivated students to ask queries about production method. Mr. Pawar (company employee) provided information about products and production process. This visit helped students to understand the production methods and working system of company and market segmentation as well.

In this Programme, the institute provides habitats to the migrating birds. After collecting empty water bottles by students, NSS volunteers prepare 50 water bottles of rectangular shape. Some grass is then put in such bottles of rectangular space. These bottles are hanged on the branches of trees in such a way to enable small birds to enter in these plastic bottles so as to create homes for them. Birds can reside in

- such bottles for longer time irrespective of rainy season, heavy breeze etc. This activity is organized and conducted to spread awareness and give a message to the society about recycling plastic waste, bird friendly and environment friendly activity. This activity enables birds to protect their habitat. It also helps to avoid migration of birds, because birds are useful tools of spreading seeds (to nurture plants) all over the world.
- Another activity to spread awareness of 'Use of Paper Bags', is regularly organized at Neral wholesale market & retail shops.
- Students also participated during Ganesh Festival in Visarjan (emersion of Ganpati idol) Day to collect plastic bags from Nirmalya (flower tributes) deposited in NirmalyaKalash. Plastic bags were given for recycling at Scrap Shop.

#### English Department:

• English Department has been continuously working towards a promising future of students. It also helps students to gain good knowledge in English by conducting various classroom activities and programmes in College. It has also made available English Language books in college library to cultivate English language skills among students. In the academic year of 2018-19, the department organized various activities such as translation activities, essay competition and handwriting activity as well.

#### Library Section:

• 'Library is the soul of every institution. Similarly, it is a big part of our College and it also plays important role to enhance the students' academic knowledge. The College Library established in the year of 2008 and it contains approximately 3200 books till date. As the library is increasing rapidly, it has been creating positive impact on students.
