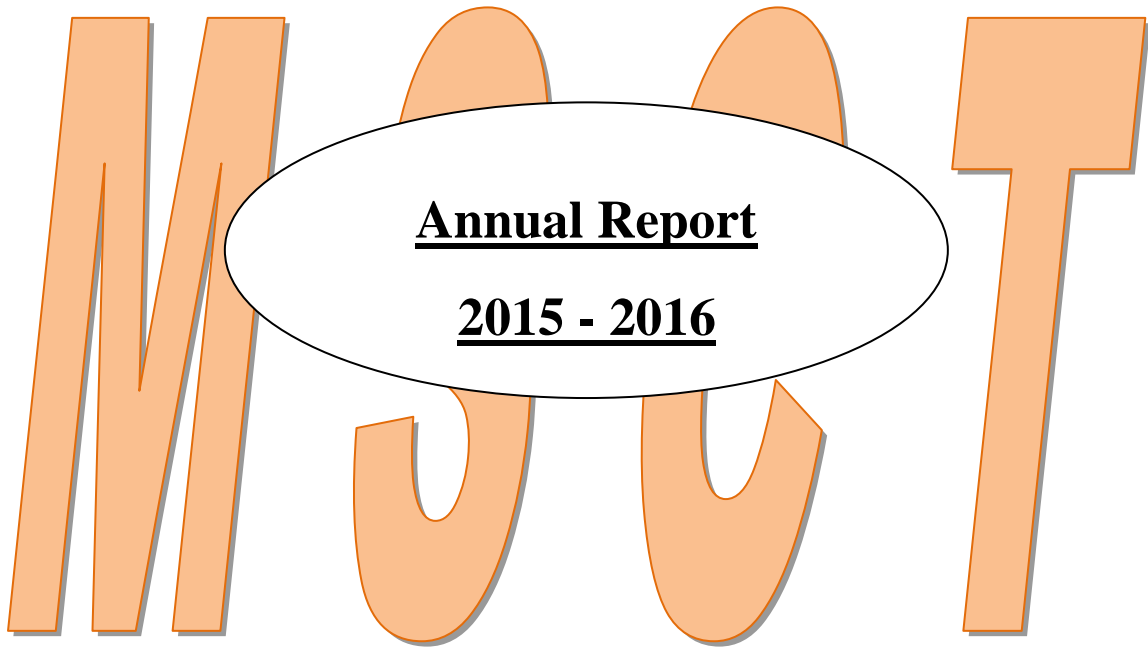

❖ **Library Section:**

Library is running very actively since the establishment of college. It just about completed 7 years.

Since 2015-2016 there was gradual increase observed in the number of books. Nearly 498 books were ordered. It consists of a wide variety of books such as reference books, encyclopedia, educational text books & supplementary or additional books.

Today, Library has total 1295 books. Library had many journals & it provides daily newspapers such as Times of India, Loksatta, Maharashtra Times, Sakal, Krushiwal, Samana, Lokmat.

In the last year President of VidyaMandir Mandal, and Hon. Adv. Mr. S.S. Phadkar had donated 12 reference books of *Income Tax Law* to our college. And Shri Rajdhashya Saheb also donated nine encyclopedias.

There are nearly 40-60 students use library for reading newspapers, every day. Our Library is well equipped with computer, books shelves & internet facility. Library has its two shelves for keeping books. There are six fan & four tube lights. For making better library work *Granthalaya 3.0* software has taken & to run their software effectively Librarian has taken training. It is the gateway to find out any type of information. It also gets within a fraction of second. Library has provided a special reading room for reading newspaper,

Reading journals. Library is going to access online journals, reference books, magazine in forth coming days.
