# Summary Annual Report

2023-24

"The Principal and the Staff of the College are pleased to present the annual report for the Academic Year 2023-24. The college conducts its activities with a commitment to quality education and the overall development of the students. Its aim is not only to impart knowledge and foster recognition but also to cultivate responsible citizenship among its students. We assess students' academic strengths and weaknesses and address their needs through various certificate courses, modules on personality development, academic, and extracurricular activities. Teachers incorporate Information & Communication Technology (ICT) and other visual aids into their teaching methods. Additionally, the college offers remedial and tutorial classes, project work, continuous internal assessment, seminars, guest lectures, and more to enrich the educational experience. The College primarily focuses on educational activities for students from backward and rural areas. It also extends financial aid to needy and backward-class students through the Student Welfare Fund."

The College has been accredited by NAAC with a 'B' grade, marking one of its greatest achievements. The student strength of the college has notably increased from 58 students in the academic year 2008-2009 to 651 students in the academic year 2023-24. The college has successfully started a Bachelor of Accounting and Finance (B.A.F.) degree program from Academic Year 2023-2024.
